U.S. Census Bureau 2015 Population Estimates: Utah

The Population Division of the U.S. Census Bureau produces annual population estimates for every state, county, and incorporated place. The most recent release, for May 2016, is for places.

This fact sheet provides a summary analysis of the population estimates for Utah, covering state, county and place level results. Rankings of size, percentage change, and absolute change are included. Data for all counties and all places (population 1,000 or more) with this comprehensive set of estimates appears at the end of the document.¹

State of Utah and National Comparisons

- From July 1, 2014 to July 1, 2015, Utah’s population grew from 2,944,498 to 2,995,919, an increase of 51,421 (1.7 percent). This was the seventh fastest growth in the nation.
- From the 2010 Census to July 1, 2015, Utah grew from 2,763,885 to 2,995,919, an increase of 232,034 (8.4 percent). This places Utah with the fifth fastest growth in the nation since the 2010 Census.

- 73.1 percent of the state’s population growth from 2014 to 2015 occurred in the four Wasatch Front counties: Salt Lake County, Utah County, Davis County, and Weber County. The largest share (28.1 percent) occurred in Salt Lake County. The growth from the 2010 Census to 2015 was also concentrated in the Wasatch Front counties, which hosted 76.8 percent of population growth.
- For cities with at least 50,000 people in 2015, the city of South Jordan had the fifth fastest population growth in the nation from 2014 to 2015, at six percent. The city grew from 62,851 in 2014 to 66,648 in 2015, an increase of 3,797.
- For cities with at least 50,000 people in 2015, the city of Lehi ranked 21st in the nation for fast-growing populations. The city experienced 3.9 percent growth, adding 2,171 people for a 2015 population of 58,486.
