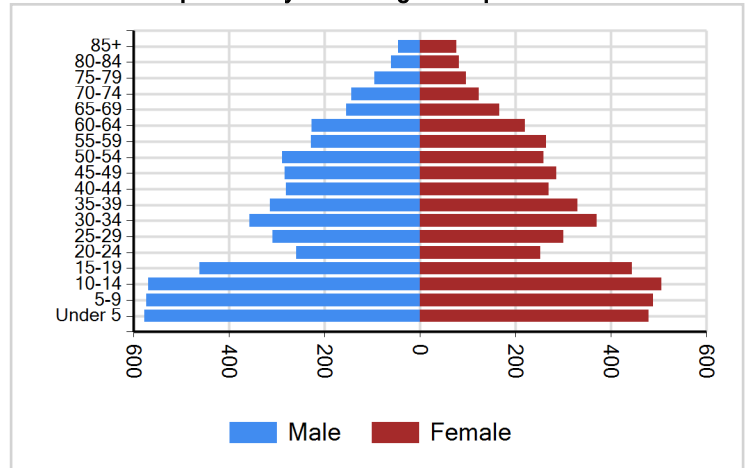

### Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



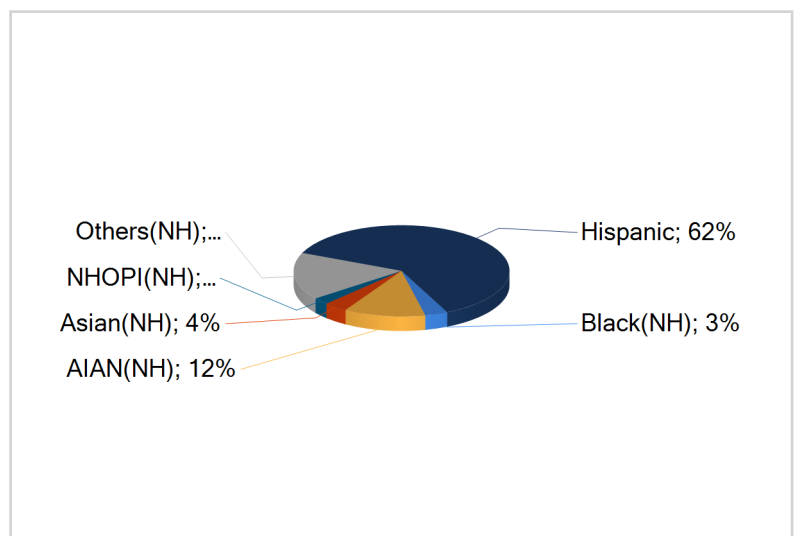

### Minority Composition



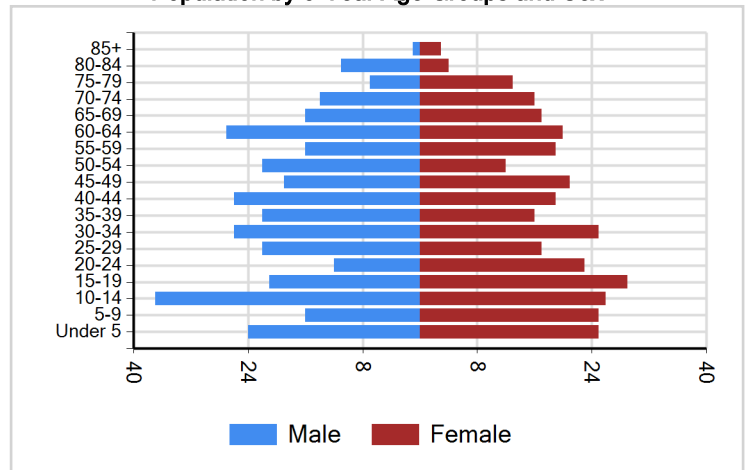

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



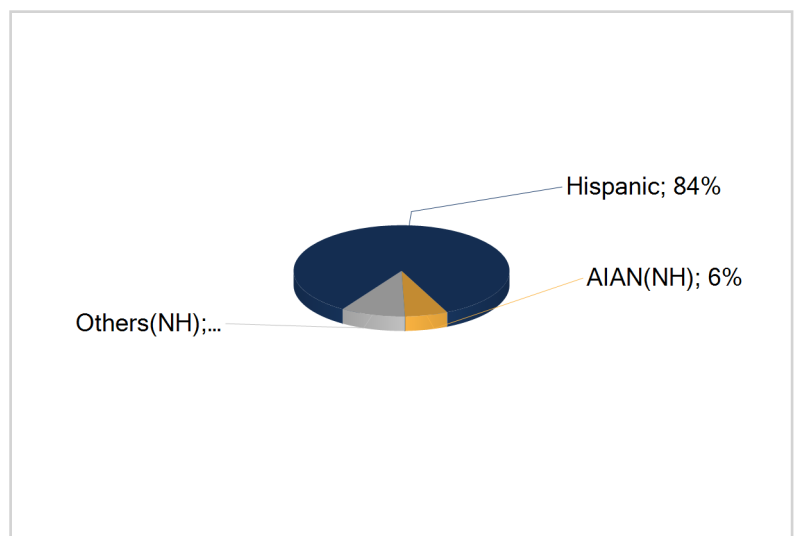

## Minority Composition



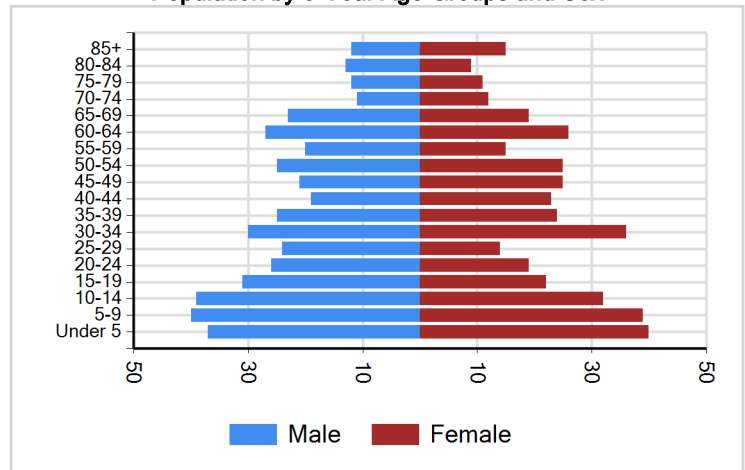

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



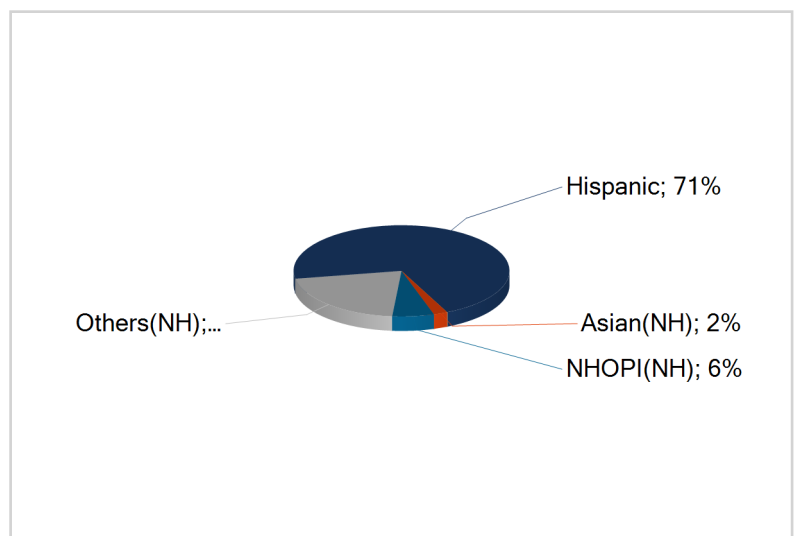

## Minority Composition



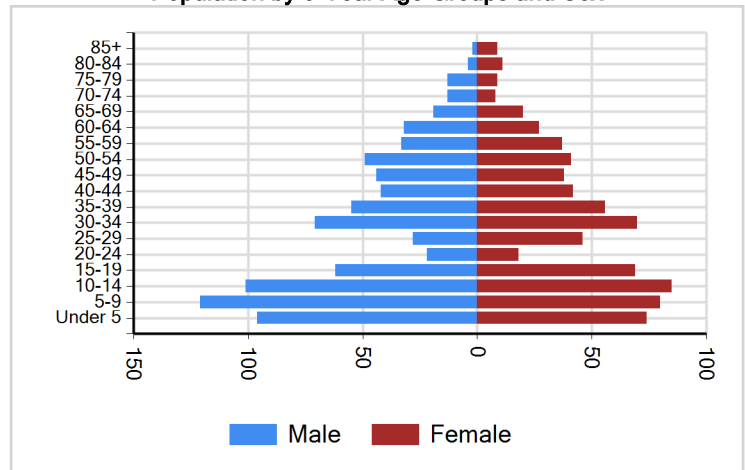

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



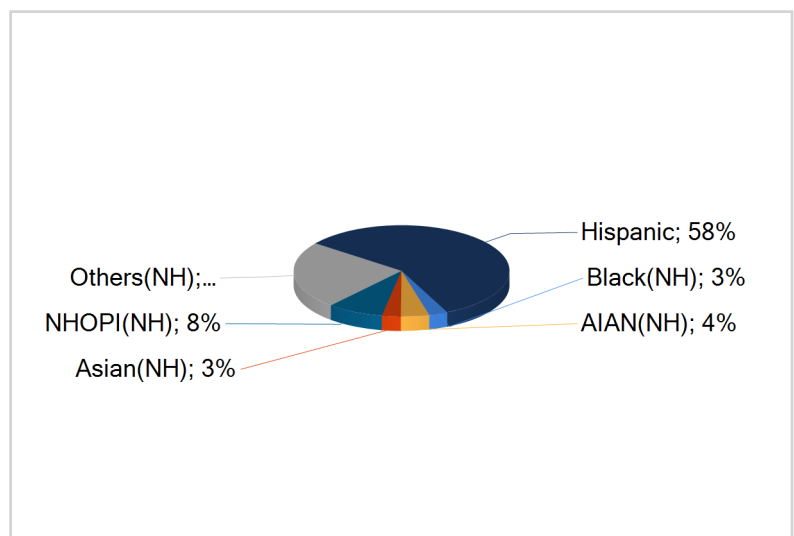

## Minority Composition



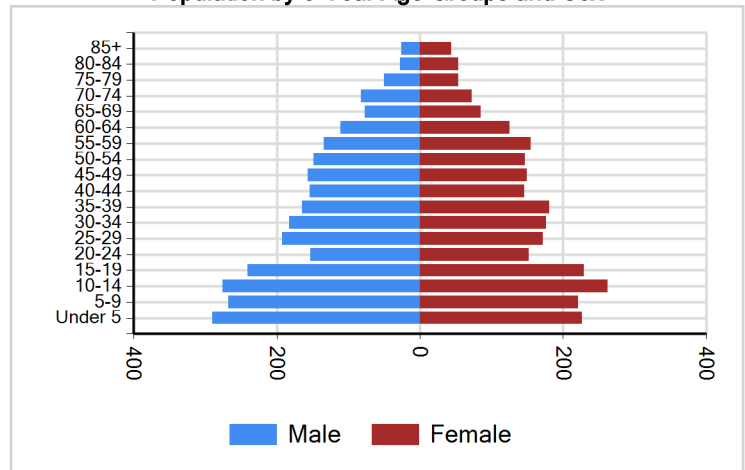

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



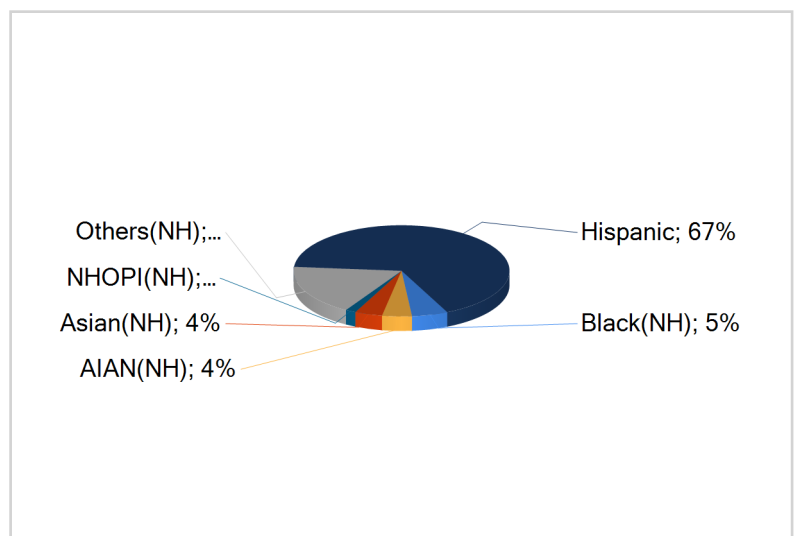

## Minority Composition



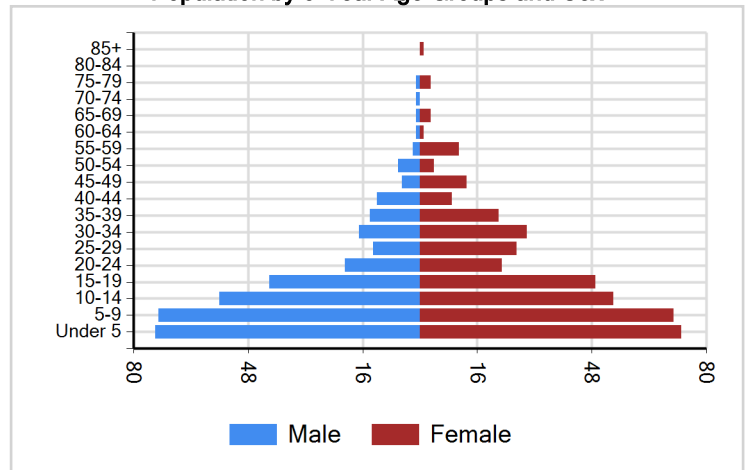

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



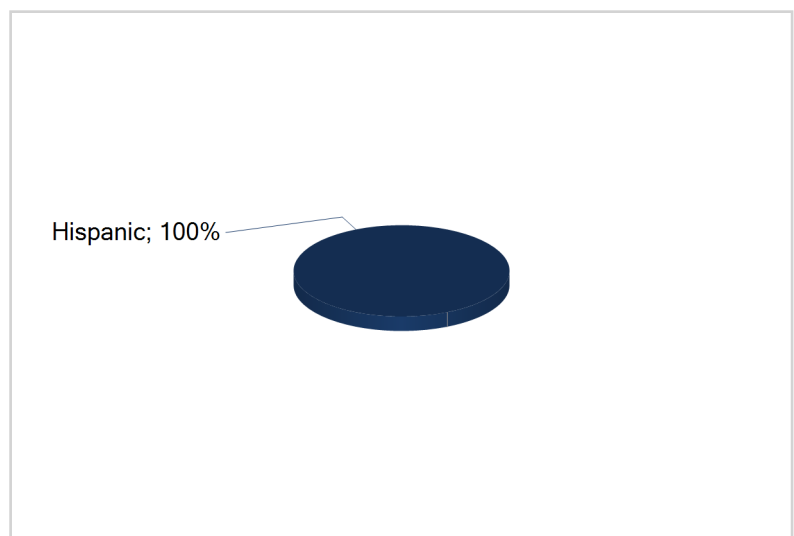
