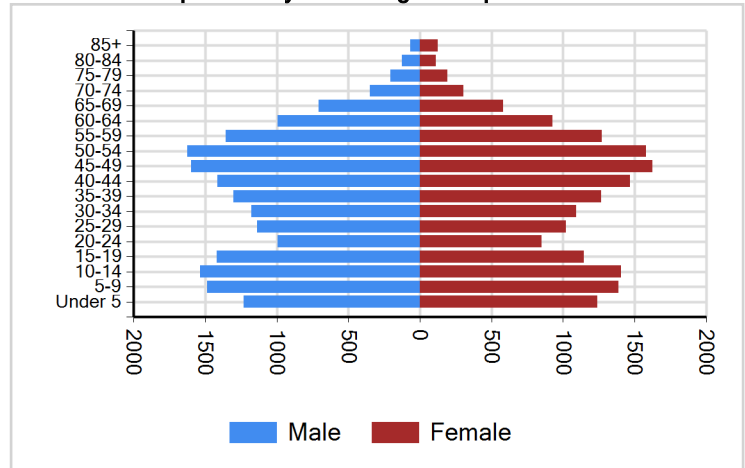

Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



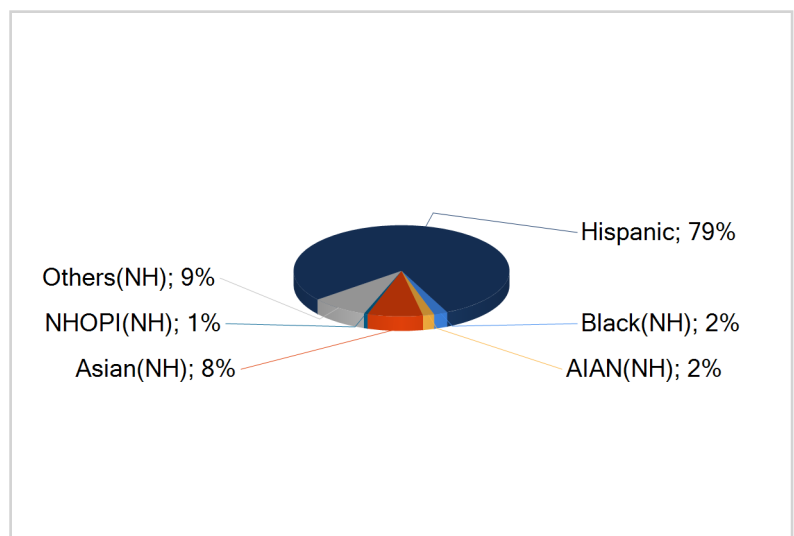

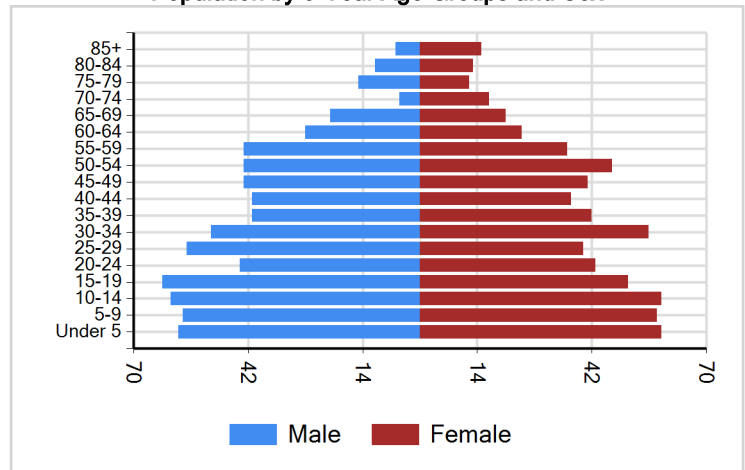

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



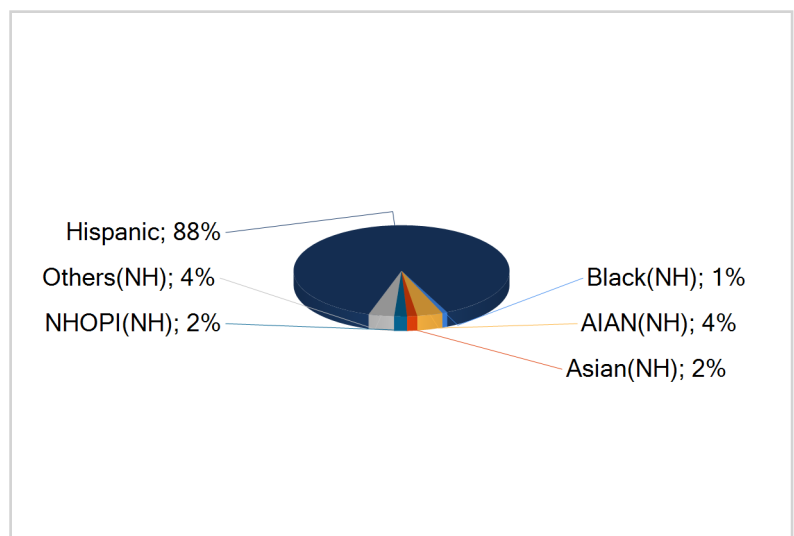

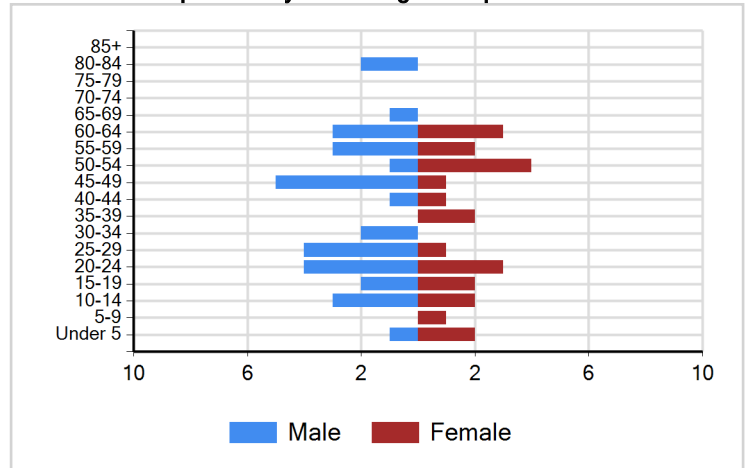

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



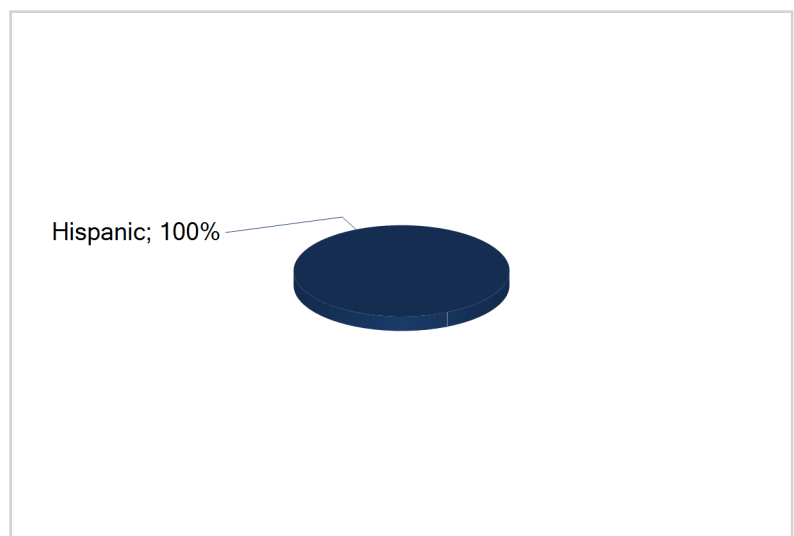

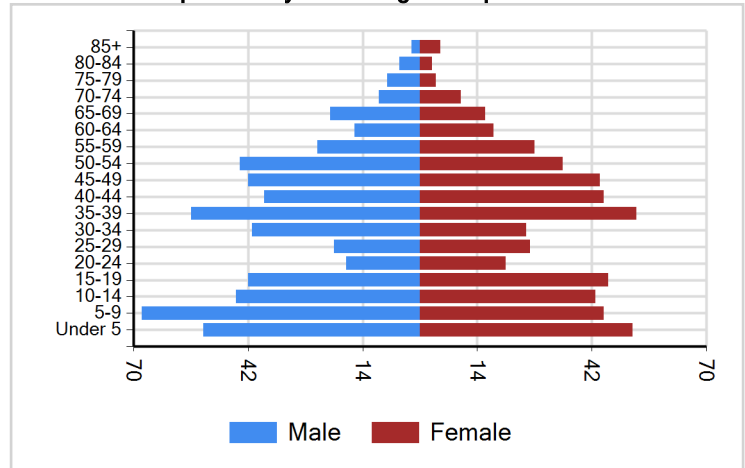

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



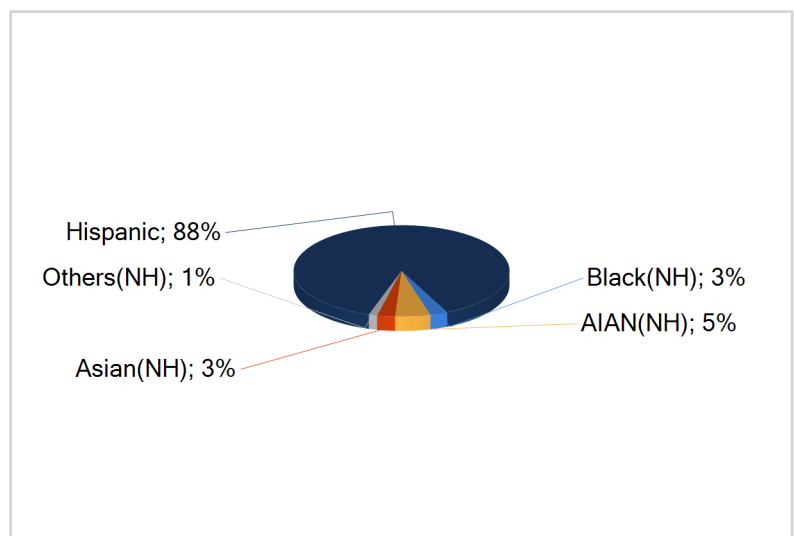

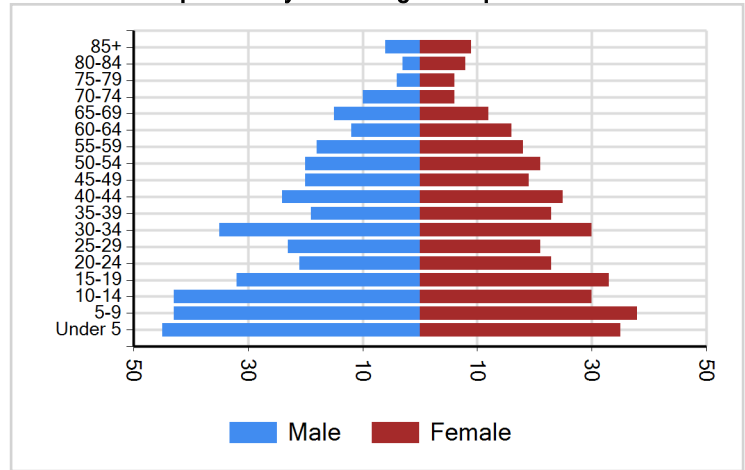

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



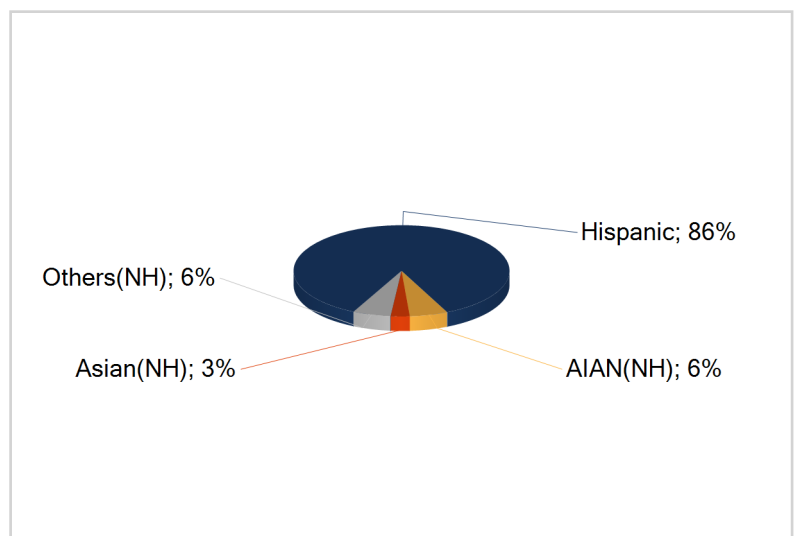

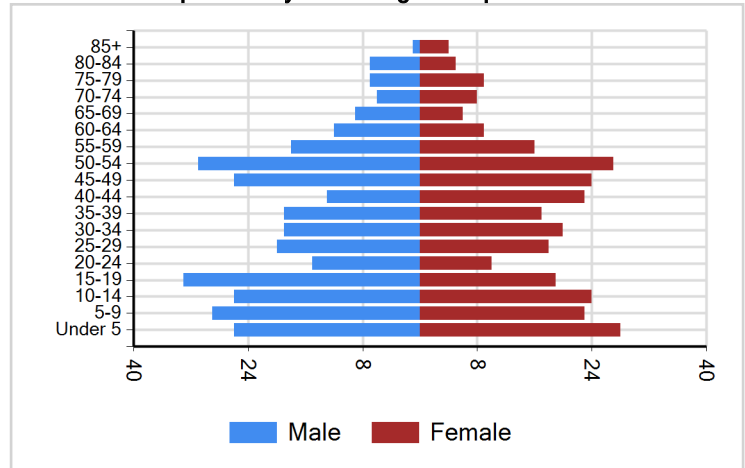

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



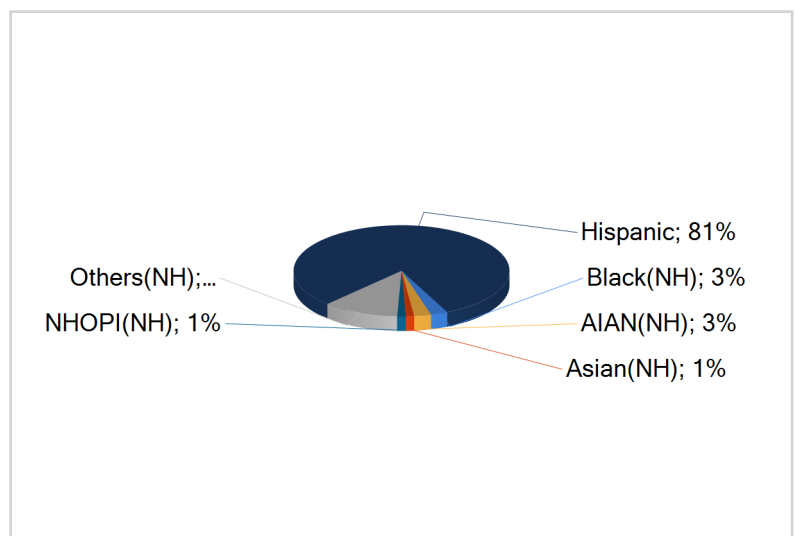

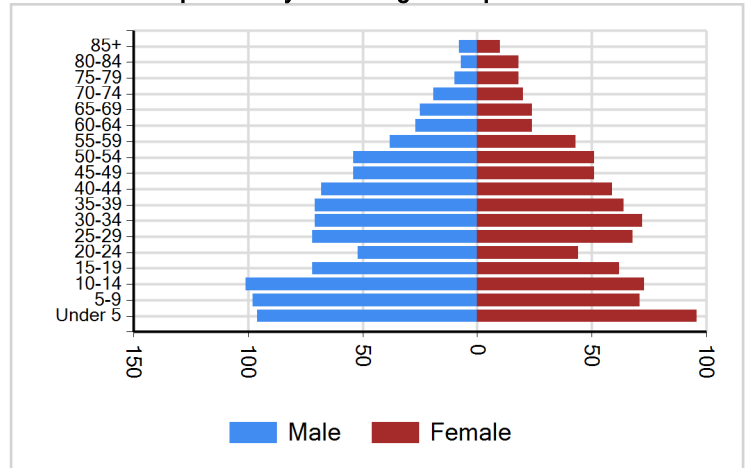

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



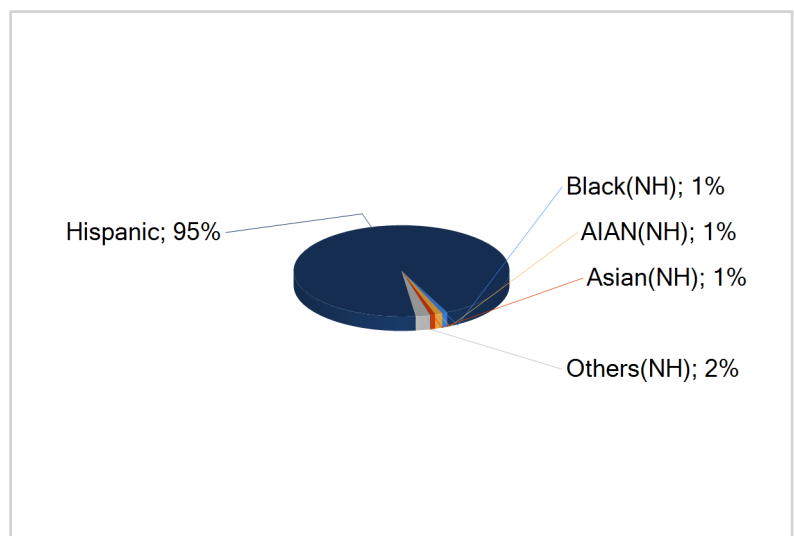

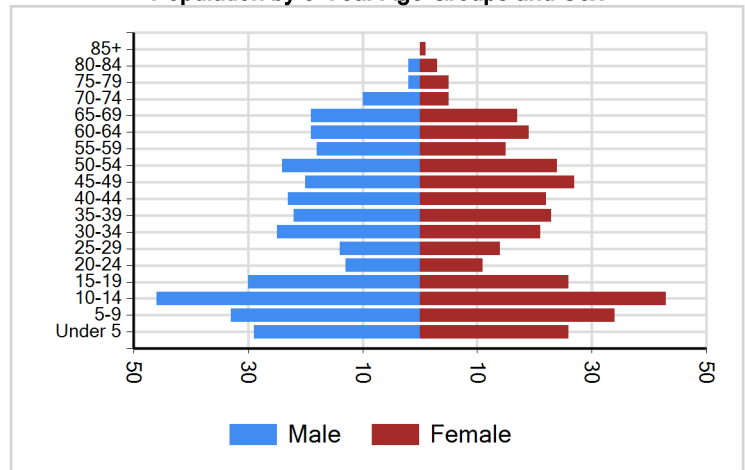

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



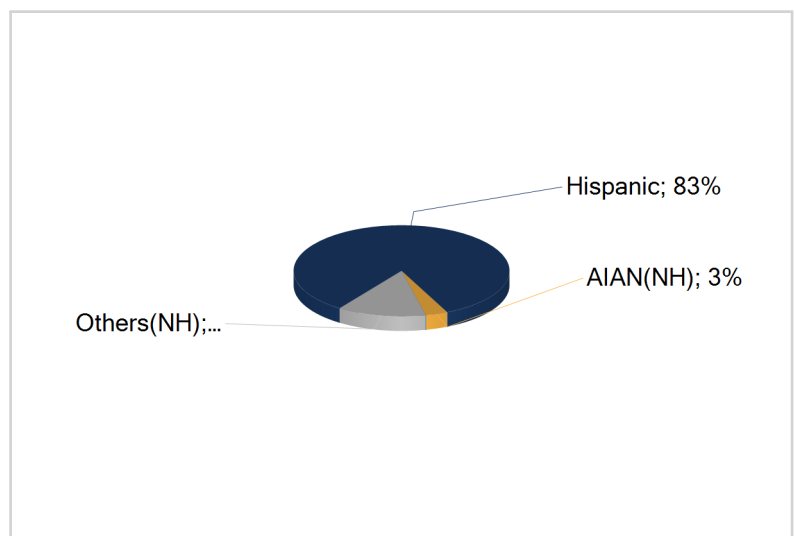

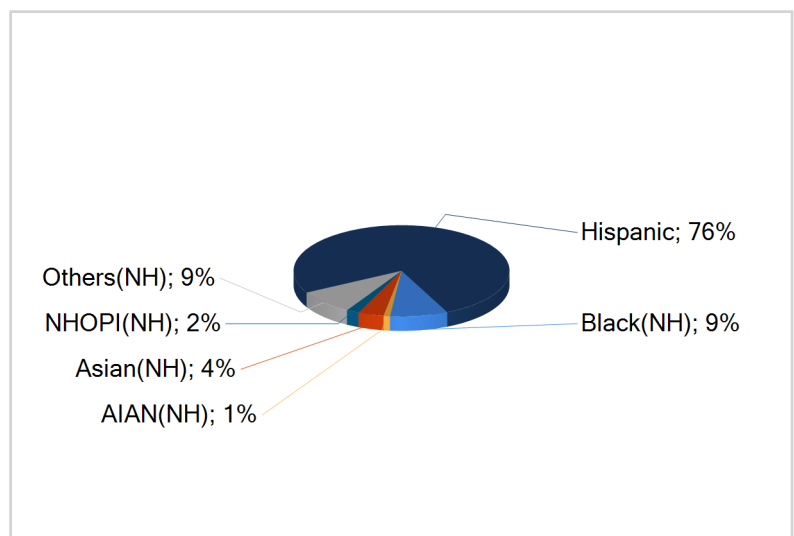

## Population by 5-Year Age Groups and Sex



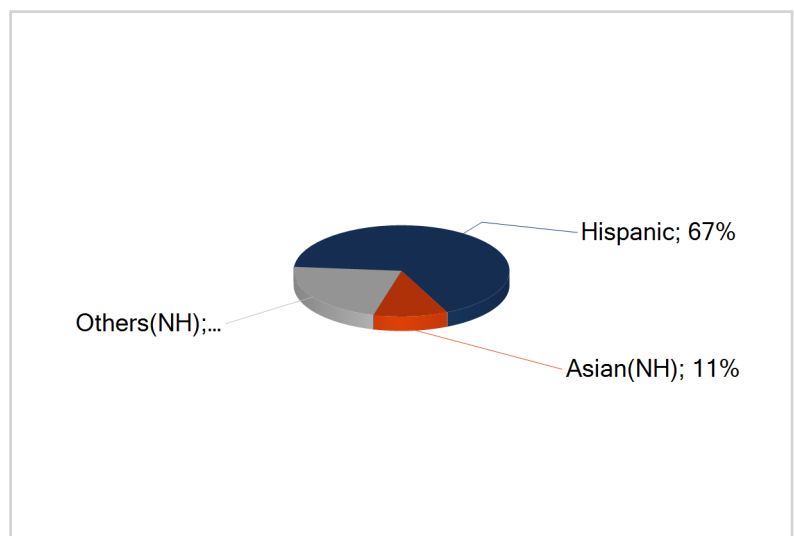
