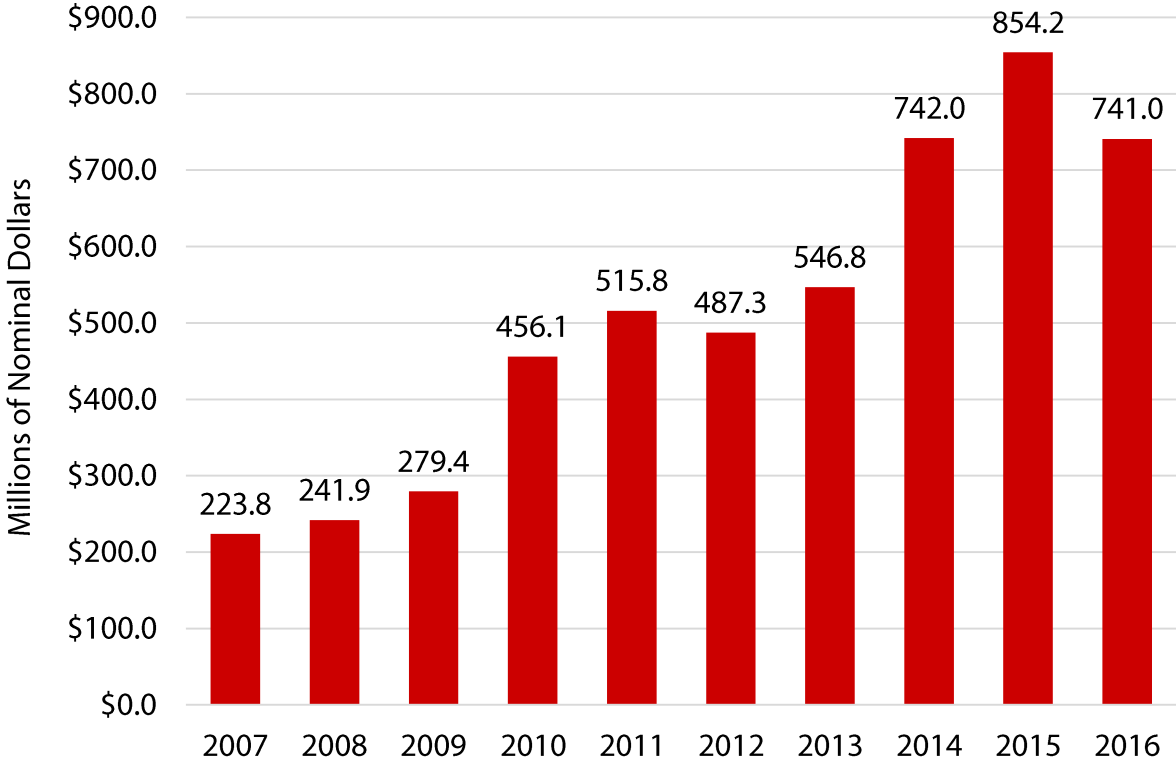

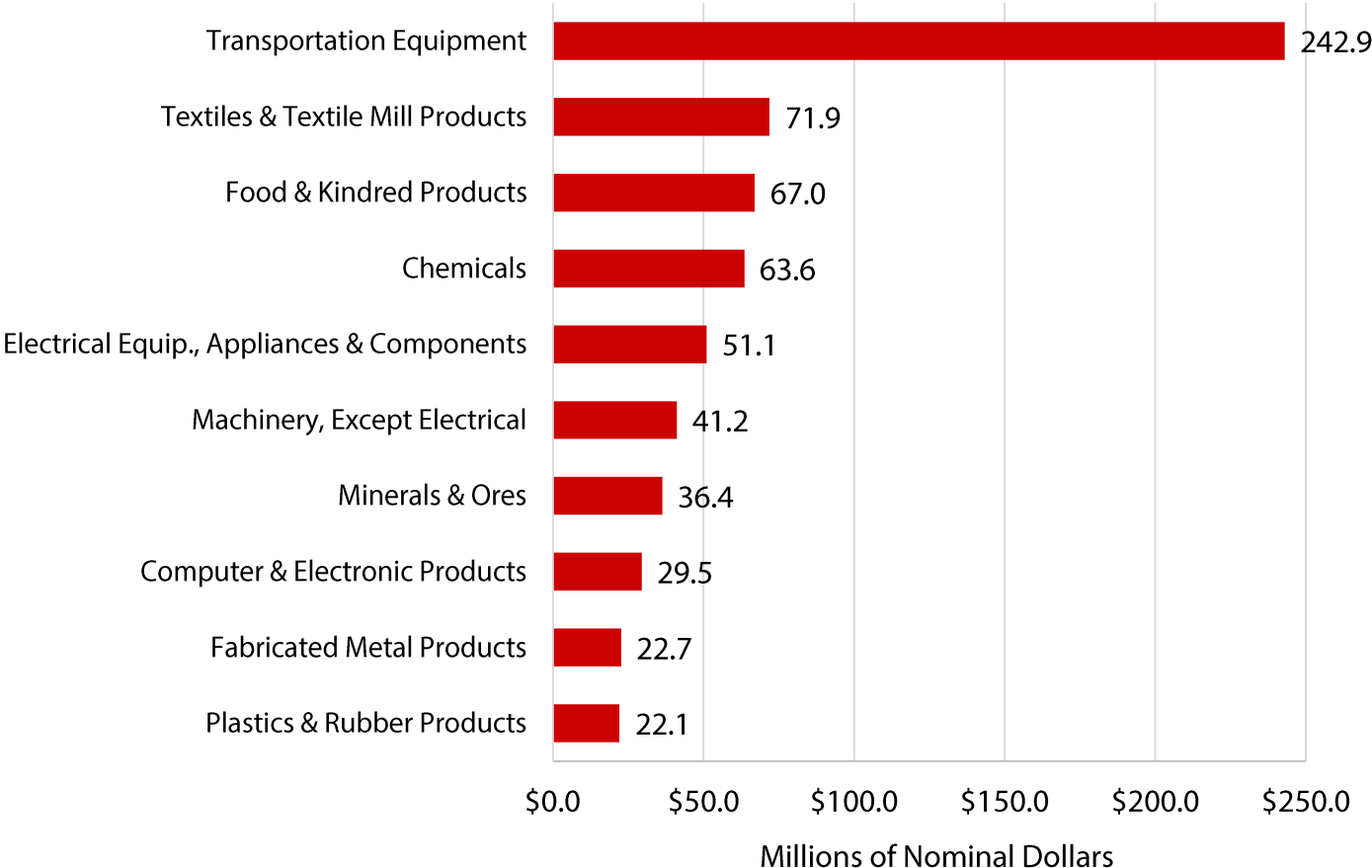

# Utah's Total Commodity Exports to Mexico



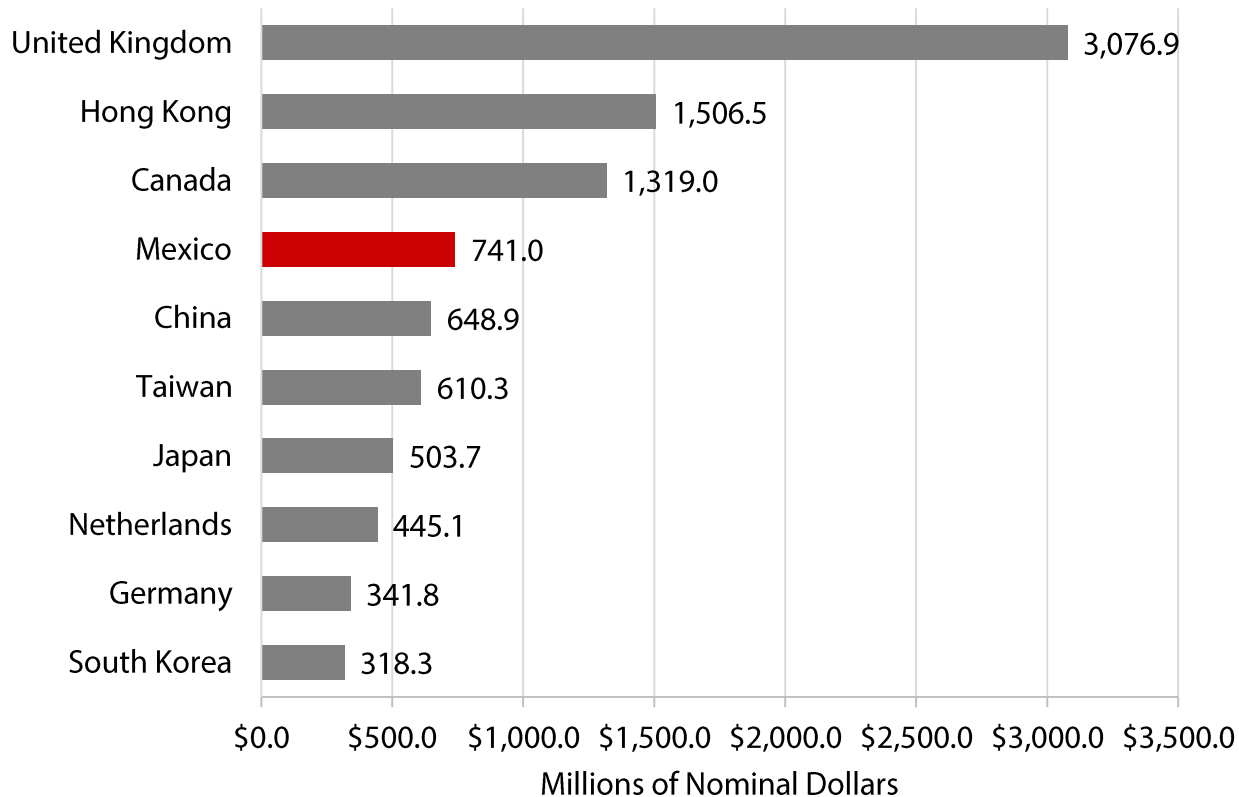

# Utah's Top Ten Commodity Exports to Mexico, 2016



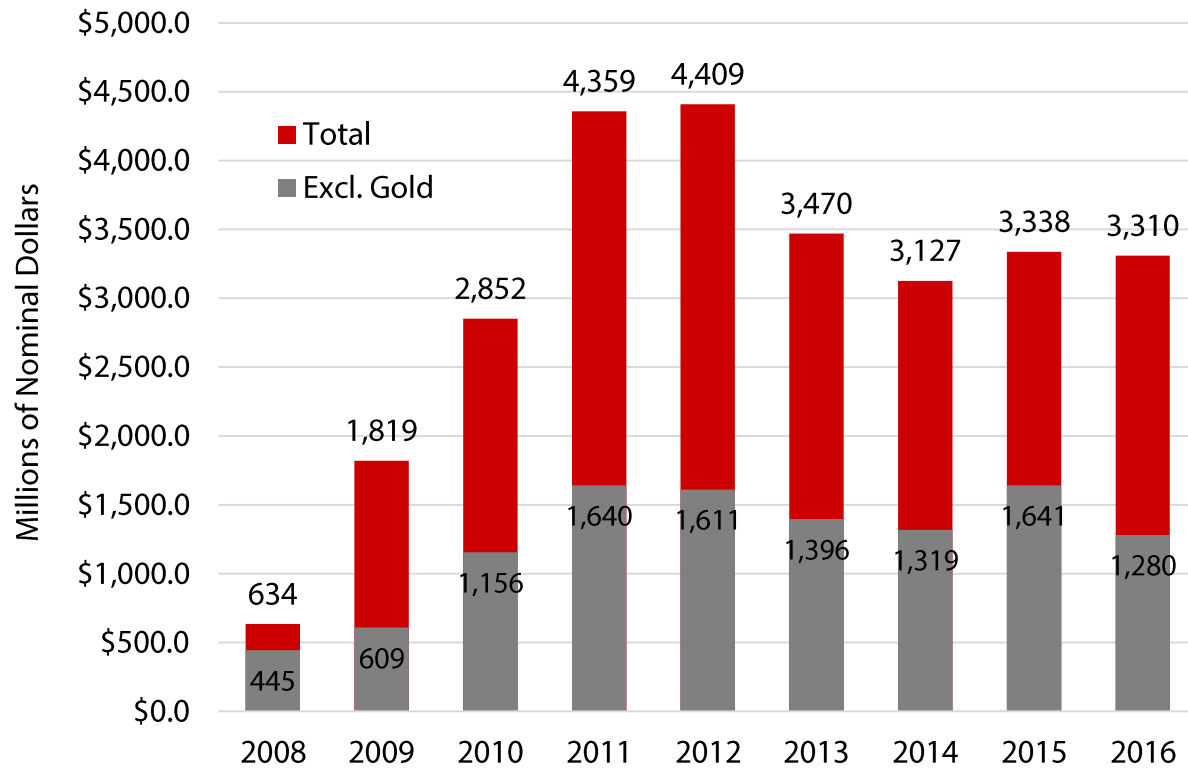

# Utah Commodity Exports to Top Ten Purchasing Countries, 2016



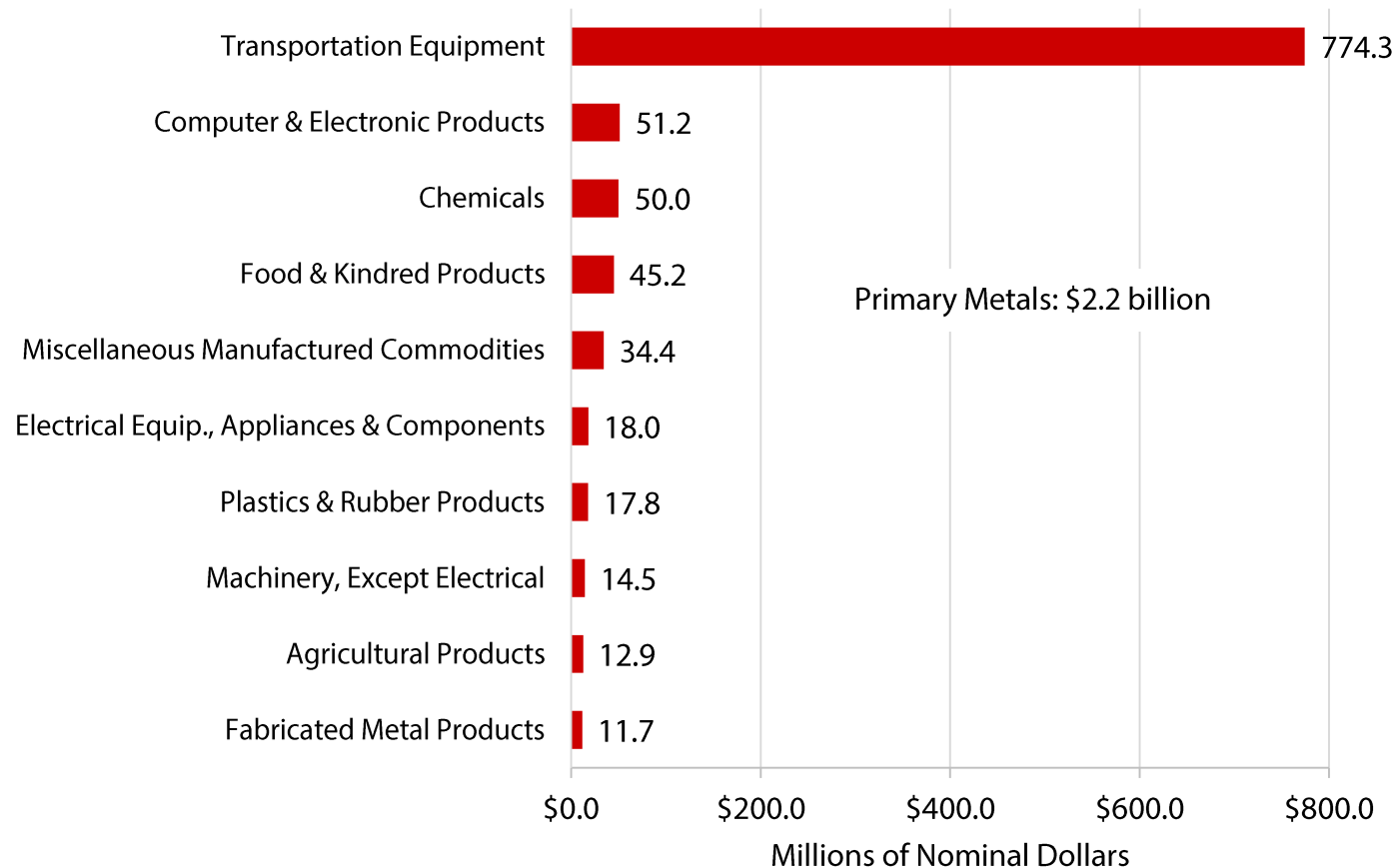
