

# First Insights – 2020 Census Utah Counties and Communities

The redistricting data is the second statistical release of the 2020 census suite of products. Key highlights include:

**Counties:**

## Wasatch County

was the **fastest-growing** county in Utah at 47.9%, growing from 23,530 to 34,788.

**Cities:**

## Herriman

added **33,359 new residents**, the most of any city, to have a 2020 population of 55,144

**While six counties grew faster than the state, seven counties experienced population declines**

Six counties that grew experienced net out-migration, meaning that **all growth was contributed by natural increase** (births exceeding deaths).

Vineyard had the most significant rate of growth, at 8,932%. This was due to a **2010 population of 139 growing to 12,543 in 2020.**

**Salt Lake City is still the largest city** in the state, at 199,723. West Valley City, West Jordan, Provo, and Orem complete the top 5 largest cities.

## What Is Redistricting Data?

The redistricting data provides selected age, race, ethnicity, group quarters, and housing unit data for counties, cities, census tracts, and other areas. The first statistical release, apportionment data, indicated that Utah was the fastest growing state in the nation.

The redistricting data informs governments in their decadal assessment of electoral boundaries. Additionally, the data provides the first findings for cities, towns, and counties from the 2020 census. This Fact Sheet highlights the decade's total population and housing unit changes in Utah communities.

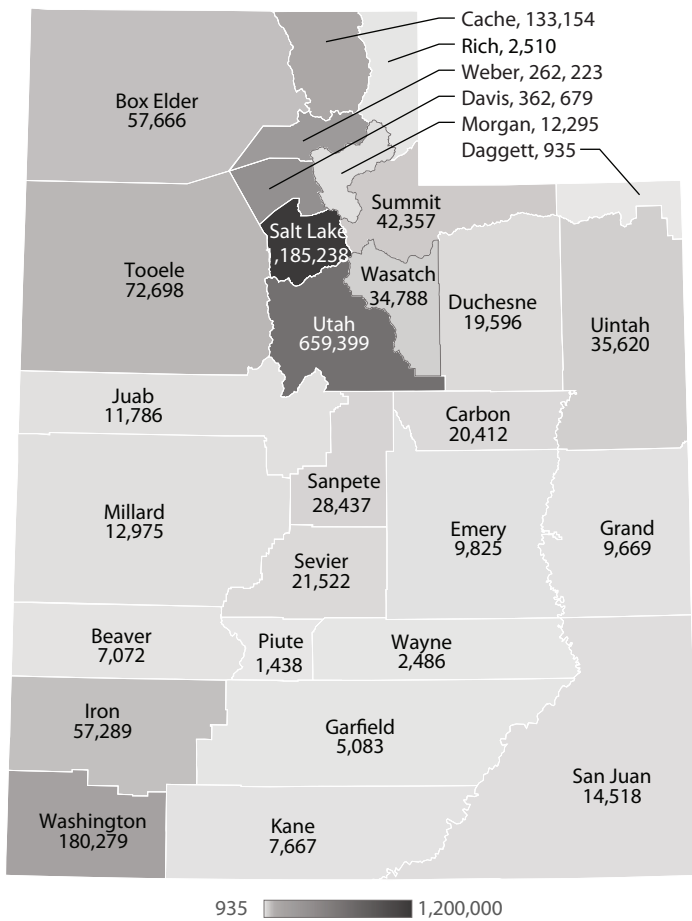

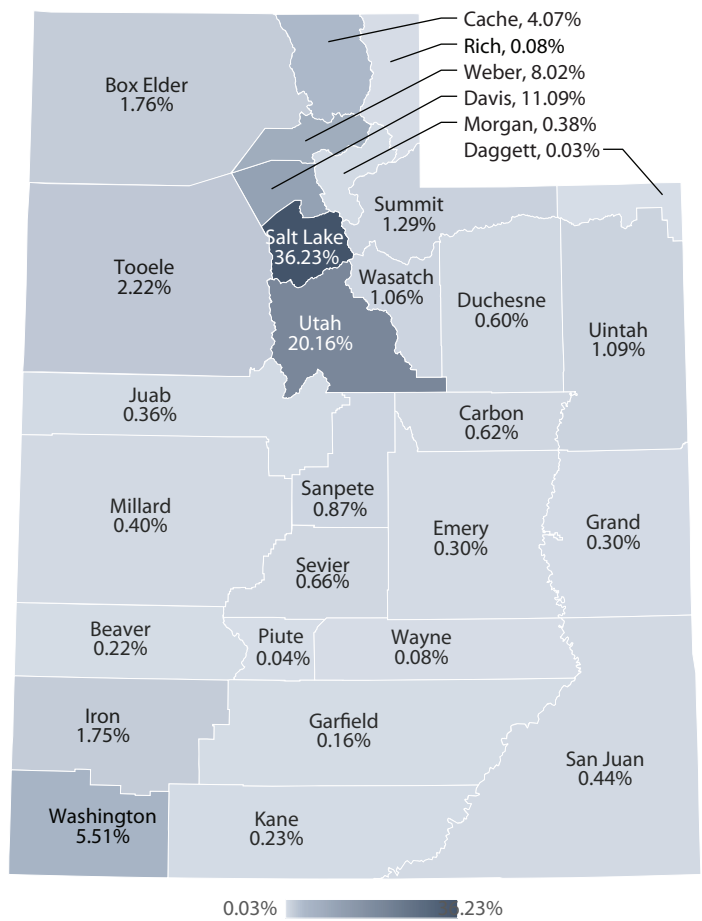

**Growth in Southern Salt Lake County and Northern Utah County Remained Strong**

Analysis throughout the decade identified northern Utah County and southern Salt Lake County as the epicenter of statewide growth. These two counties were responsible for 59% of statewide growth this decade. Salt Lake County remains the state’s dominant population center as home to 36% of the state’s population. Salt Lake County had highest absolute increase at 155,583 residents or 15.1% increase, with 70% of growth due to natural increase. Utah County gained 142,835 residents, a 27.7% increase from 2010. Like the overall state growth, two-thirds of Utah County’s growth was driven by natural increase and one-third from net migration.

Cities like Vineyard, Lehi, Eagle Mountain, and Saratoga Springs drove Utah County’s growth. These cities represented 58% of countywide growth between 2010 and 2020. The southern end of Salt Lake County drove the considerable growth there, with Herriman, South Jordan, and Bluffdale contributing 45% of countywide growth. Larger cities like Salt Lake City and West Jordan both added around 13,000 new residents.

**Housing Units**

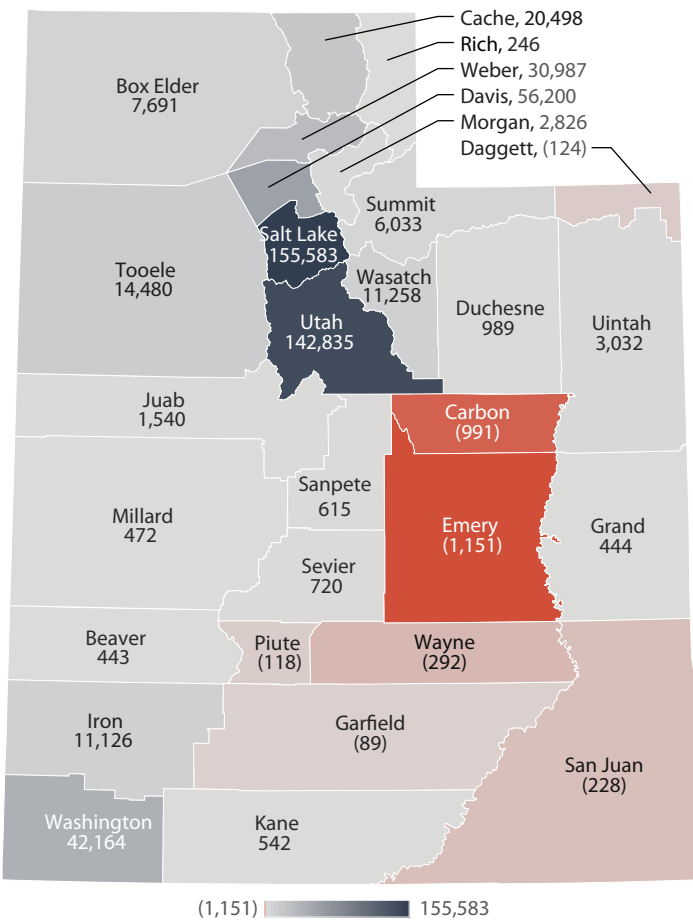
Wasatch County’s significant growth was also highlighted in housing units. With an increase of 36.7% or 3,885 to reach 14,462 housing units in 2020. Utah County had the second highest rate of housing unit growth at 29.8%, reaching a total of 192,570 units. Washington County was a close third at 29.1% or 16,796 new units, totaling 74,530 in 2020. Salt Lake County added the largest number of units.

**Wasatch, Washington, and Morgan Counties experienced the fastest growth**

Wasatch County grew by 47.9% to a total population of 34,788. Growth in Heber and Midway contributed over two-thirds (67%) of this growth.

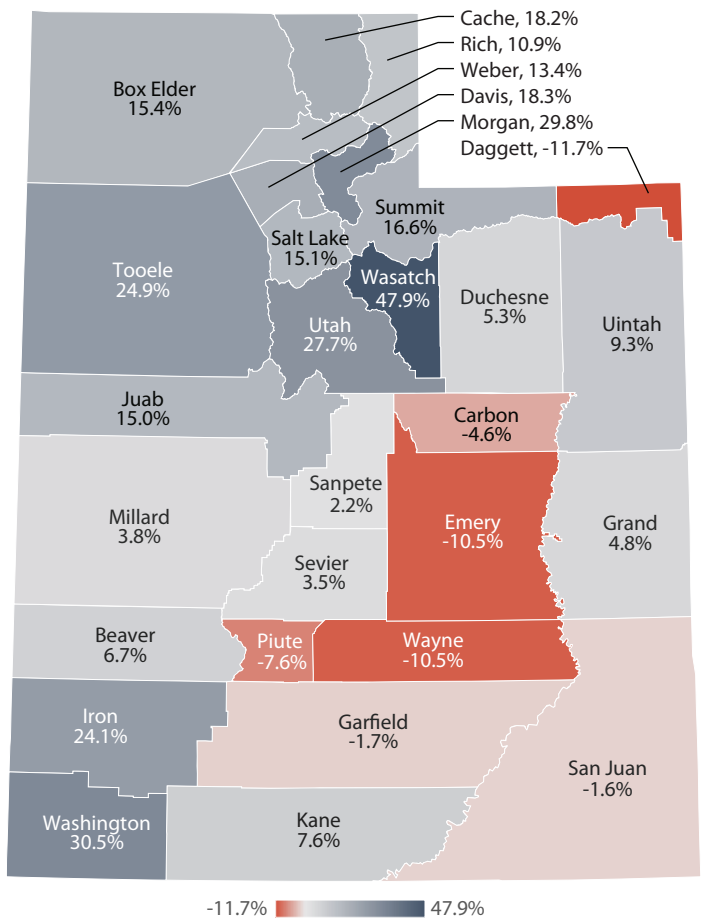
Both Washington and Morgan counties grew by about 30%. In Washington County, net migration was responsible for 77% of growth, translating to an overall total of 42,164 new residents. New St. George residents provided more than half of this growth (22,445), with Washington and Hurricane adding an additional 15,000 residents (9,232 and 6,288, respectively). The

growth in Morgan resulted in 2,826 new residents, the majority coming from Mountain Green. About two-thirds of this growth was from new residents moving to Morgan County. Table 4 shares population data for each county's cities and towns.

**Declines in Smaller Utah Communities**

While Utah was the fastest-growing state in the nation between 2010 and 2020, communities throughout the state didn't experience this growth evenly. Seven counties, Carbon, Daggett, Emery, Garfield, Piute, San Juan, and Wayne, lost population. Emery County had the largest loss, at 1,151 while Garfield County had the smallest at 118. While Piute County experienced out-migration and natural decline (fewer births than deaths), negative net migration drove these population changes in the remaining six counties.
