

Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute - QAMO Internship

Internship:

The Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute and the Quantitative Analysis of Markets and Organizations (QAMO) major are partnering to offer one QAMO student/semester the opportunity to intern with the Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute. The intent of the internship is as follows:

- Provide hands-on experience to conduct research and analysis in support of economic and public policy issues
- Provide exposure to events, activities and individuals related to government, business and economic/public policy
- Provide the student with real-world experience to be leveraged as they move forward with their education and career
- Responsibilities may vary based upon the semester and projects being worked on

Number of Students: One QAMO student/semester

Duration: One semester beginning Spring 2022 – In-person

Time Commitment: 10 hours/week (student has the option of applying for 1.0 academic credit hour under Business 5880).

Pay: \$2,000/semester

Suggested applicant requirements:

- Sophomore/Junior
- Minimum GPA of 3.3
- Strong interest in the administration of government, public policy and/or economics

Application Process:

- Submit resume and provide writing sample (1 page) addressing the following question: “What interests you in the Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute/QAMO internship and how would this internship align with your future career goals?”
- Those selected (based on their resume and personal statement) will then have an interview with a representative of the Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute via Zoom. Once the Gardner Institute goes through the applications they will reach out directly with qualified applicants to set up zoom interviews.
