Median Net Wealth by Race/Ethnicity and Tenure, U.S., 2019




Renters are Stuck Renting

Share of Households By Tenure that Can't Afford a Median Priced Home, Utah January, 2023





Rents Peaked & are Coming Down Asking Rents by County




A Decade of Rent Increases in Two Year

Percent Change in Average Apartment Rent, and Renter Median Income, in the Wasatch Front Counties, 2016 – 2021




