





Cumulative Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims beginning March 16, 2020




Percent of County Workforce






Percent of Industry Jobs, through May 10







Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims beginning March 16, 2020




Cumulative Industry Claims, through May 3





