




Percent of County Workforce



Percent of Total Workforce




Percent of Industry Jobs, through May 10




Places with 1,000 + Cumulative Claims, through May 16







Cumulative Industry Claims, through May 3








Cumulative Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims Percent of County Workforce





